As part of the narrative, we need to focus on policymakers' negligence for allowing the funding of fossil fuel projects incompatible with the Paris Agreement. We also need to highlight the destructive impact of new fossil fuel projects on frontline communities.

This narrative is important because the funding of fossil fuel projects affects almost every country in some way: by either providing funding for new projects, or for an actual project built there already, or it ensures our experiencing the effects of the climate crisis. Instead, we need massive funding for renewables worldwide to enable a just energy transition for the benefit of all.
